

Presenting a candidacy for the 2019 the Princess of Girona Foundation's International Award is very simple. Once you <u>start your registration</u> you will receive an access code that will allow you to fill in the candidacy form.

The candidacy form consists of 7 sections: I. General details of the candidacy; II. Summary of career; III. Area of action; IV. Differentiation; V. Impact; VI. Globality; VII. Additional information.

- I. General details of the candidacy: You will be asked for the name and citizenship of the candidate, and the contact information of the person who is nominating the candidate.
- II. Summary of career: Briefly describe the candidate's biography, highlighting their personal, academic and professional experience. Remember that the candidacy will be evaluated for its ability to achieve and excel in the development of projects, especially if they have entailed difficulty or risk. It is especially important to highlight the candidate's achievements and any failures they have overcome in each of the projects undertaken, their role in each project and their personal motivation for carrying them out.
- **III.** Area of action: You need to indicate the geographical area of influence of the candidate.
- IV. Differentiation: Describe, illustrating with examples, the three most important aspects which demonstrate the distinctive characteristics of the candidate including, if it is the case, the capacity to overcome difficulties
- V. Impact: In this section you will be asked to describe the candidate's projects and or works with impact in terms of capacity to provide tangible and significant achievements.
- VI. Globality: Briefly describe the influence and impact of the candidate's projects, its applicability and the knowledge developed and consider the public recognition.
- VII. Additional information: Any other information about the candidate that you might want to add such as news in the press, recognitions received, etc.
